



Dear Family and Friends,

It's been since October that we've sent out an update! Not that there hasn't been anything to report, but rather, we've been crazy busy with many exciting adventures! We are grateful for your interest in our wanderings, and are requesting extra prayer in the next few weeks as we head to...

UGANDA!

As we've shared before, a wonderful door has opened in Jinja, Uganda, to bring Destiny School of Ministry (DSM) to a large network of African pastors! We're even now preparing to run a 10 day conference and DSM training in June of this year. So this coming Tuesday, we'll be flying out for a short week in Uganda to meet our hosts, and establish the infrastructure, secure accommodations, and make plans for DSM with the hosting church. We're super excited, as Uganda is new territory for us!

Please be praying for us over the next couple of weeks for...

- Safety and health as we travel... right now, we are iced in, and can't even leave our house! It should be clear by Tuesday, but Washington DC is also under heavy winter weather, and that's our route to Uganda.
- Great relationships to be established with Pastor Robert and Joy Muhumuza, and the others who are hosting us for the training
- Strategy to be released for the school... sensing that God will unfold his plans while we're on the ground there
- Administrative anointing for all arrangements to be made
- Finances for the trip: we're about half way there
- Wedding... we'll also be joining in the celebration of the marriage of one of our DSM Kenya students who was our connection to Uganda!

And as we prepare for the June DSM....

- For the team to be finalized... we still have several pending applications. If ALL of those end up coming with us, we'll be a team of almost 30!!
- Creativity released... the Zion dance company will be part of the school, as well as having a focus on worship arts, pastoral and leadership training.
- Teaching team... several new team members to be released into teaching roles. Discerning what is most on God's heart for the group
- Administrative and leadership anointing... we've never led a group this big
- Finances... this is huge for all of us! Appx \$2,500 per team member! Also, funding for the pastors coming who are not able to cover their costs fully

BEYOND UGANDA...

We are also making plans for a local DSM in August, as well as hosting many international leaders for our yearly Overflow Conference in September. Following the conference, we will be organizing and leading two further weeks of DSM training for those who can stay on! More on that in the next letter!

FAMILY NEWS

Nick and Melissa are doing well, adjusting to married life and growing closer to one another! We see them several times a week, and LOVE our interaction together. Melissa is being trained into a new job in the medical arena, and is enjoying this new assignment.

Kim has also started a new job after several months off work recovering from her surgery and complications. She is living in Costa Mesa, CA, and we get to see her usually twice a year.

We are enjoying great health (for growing older people!), with the minor aches and pains that seem to follow the graying hair! We've joined a new gym, and are 'addicted' to working out at least 4-5 times a week. We're feeling much better for it!

TESTIMONIES

We wanted to share a cool testimony of God's goodness to His kids! Last fall, we were challenged to get a new vehicle, as our 1996 Ford Explorer isn't dependable for long trips anymore. We didn't see how we could possibly finance a newer (gently used) vehicle, but we started to pray. At the same time, we were also praying for funds for a laptop for Deb for her frequent teaching trips. We found what we wanted for about \$560.

So, in November, we were meeting with some Amsterdam colleagues from our Europe days, and discovered that because of living so many years in the Netherlands, we qualify for a Dutch pension!! So we're in the process of that paperwork, and Greg will be receiving an initial lump sum of about \$4,500, and then \$300 per month for the rest of his life! When Deb turns 65, she will also be receiving \$300 per month! We were floored, and through that, God has provided for the new car!!! We are loving our new (to us!) 2011 Ford Escape! We felt the Lord directing us to give our Explorer to someone in our church, and just committed the loss of trade in value (about \$1,000) to the Lord. Within 24 hours, we received an unexpected gift for \$1,000!!!

The same weekend, we returned home to find a check in the mail from a class action lawsuit that we didn't remember that we were even a part of. It was for \$550.02! So Deb is now enjoying her new laptop! We had no idea how either of these items could be financed in the normal way, but our God is not a 'normal' God! He is very supernatural, creative, and He has proven Himself faithful again!

We are so grateful for each of you who have expressed an interest in our ministry. We could not do what we do without your prayers, love, encouragement, and financial support! Every blessing, much grace and shalom peace on y'all!
