The new year is well underway, snow has already fallen, the Smoky Mountains are white, and we are anticipating a brand new season of fruitfulness. Because of having more than a dozen countries asking us to bring Destiny School of Ministry (DSM) to their nations, we are looking for God-given strategies to raise up other leaders who can run with the vision, and for other creative ways to multiply out into the corners of the earth. To that end...

## **DSM VIDEO FILMING**

Beginning tomorrow (Friday the 29<sup>th</sup>), we are launching the filming of our DSM curriculum, recording about 25 sessions and developing workbooks to go along with the teachings. This will enable the material to be widely spread out to some of the places and people we would not otherwise be able to serve. Deb's series on Hearing God's Voice is first up, and so we're scrambling to get ready for a whole new learning experience. Filming will continue into the spring, and we hope to have the package done by the summer. Greg, our Pastors Jim and Peggy, and Deb will do the main portion of the teaching. We've had some great input from some professional film people, as well as our very talented videographers and photographers here in the church. **Please be praying for this new ministry venture.**

## **DEB'S TEACHING TRIPS**

This coming Sunday afternoon, Deb will be flying to San Francisco to speak for a week to a group of missionaries-in-training. She loves investing there once or twice a year, as the training and outreach center is located in the heart of the Tenderloin district, full of immigrants, as well as many homeless, drug addicts, and marginalized residents. Anyone brave enough to live and serve in such an area is our hero, and that's just the sort of people we love pouring into. **Prayer for anointing, favor, wisdom, and protection would be appreciated.** She will then spend the weekend with her dad and family in Sacramento, returning home in time to see only the END of the Superbowl!!

Then, on March 11, she will be traveling with a colleague to Central Asia, to two closed-access nations to teach young believers for 5 days in each place. She's had one of these nations in her heart for about 8 years, so to be invited to speak there is THRILLING!!! They get few trainers willing to come to these end-of-the-world places, but the hunger is great. **She needs a strong prayer cover for this assignment, as this is brand new territory! We're trusting God for stamina, health, protection, and anointing, as well as finances as these ministry centers are unable to reimburse them for any of their travel or ministry costs (about \$3,000-)! Greg has also been involved in helping to mentor some of the young men in the congregation in prayer, including a Kenyan brother who has come for several months. This quality young man was one of our translators in the Kenya DSM, and has planted a church in the slums of Nairobi. We are honored to have him with us for these weeks.

Sunday morning of last week, Greg began having pain in his lower abdomen. By that evening, we landed at the ER and he was taken almost straight in to surgery to remove his appendix, as well as to repair an unexpected minor hernia!!! Released less than 24 hours later, he was resting at home, watching a gorgeous snowfall. We were housebound for several days, until the plows cleared our street. Beautiful!! Thankfully, he is doing well now.
